WEEK 3: INTIMATE GROWING IN RELATIONSHIP

These reflection guides are designed to supplement the videos, for use in a small group Bible study. They are created for the leader's ease of use, and with links to free web-based resources.

REFLECTION

The exchange of names is the beginning of knowing and being known, the beginning of intimacy.

SCRIPTURE

Read Exodus 3:1-15. The call of Moses at the burning bush revealed to Moses more of who God is through God's name.

Read any of the following: These are all stories in Scripture which include a name for God, where something more about God's character was revealed: Exodus 17:15, Judges 6:24, Genesis 22:14, Ezekiel 48:35, Genesis 16:13, Matthew 11:25

These are places where others gave God a name, based on their intimate experiences of their relationship with God.

Reading the surrounding context can help reveal why that name was so meaningful.

DISCUSSION

- What is your full name? How did you come to be named that? What does your name mean? How do you feel about your name?
- If you could give yourself a name, the meaning of which truly reflects who you are, what would it be? In other words, who are you in the core of your being?
- Does it change anything knowing that God knows you and calls your name?
- Share about a time when you had a profound experience of God's presence, when you felt most intimately connected to God.
- Throughout Scripture, people gave God names based on their experiences with God. What name would you give God, based on what God means to you/how you are relating to God these days? (you can also use the list linked in the "article" section below)

For Further Study:

Scripture records hundreds of names for God, each showing something about God. Which one resonates with you most right now? Look it up and study the story in its context
