REFLECTION

They are at an ancient water source, but Jesus is pointing to a source beyond that, a source he knows personally.

SCRIPTURE

Read John 4:5-42. The story of Jesus' offer of living water to the woman at the well, and the difference it made.

Read any of the following:

These are Scripture verses about water:

John 7:37-38, Isaiah 43:19-21, Genesis 2:5-10, Rev. 22:1-3, Isaiah 41:17-18, Isaiah 44:3, Isaiah 58:11-12, Psalm 1:1-3

Read BCP 304-305. The Baptismal Covenant.

DISCUSSION

- Share a story about a time when you heard God's voice (see Matt 3:16-17) Maybe it wasn't audible, but you knew God was speaking to you. Describe that experience and the context.
- Which Scriptures about water are your favorite? Why?
- What difference does your being baptized make in your own life and in the world? How does it shock the world when you offer communion rather than division?
- Where do you need God's living water in your life right now?
- How is Jesus' living water springing up in you and through you to others these days? How do you want it to?
