Typography Overview



- DIN Next LT Pro should always appear as all caps and in the condensed family.
- Lora should always appear in sentence case.
- Only use Lora Bold to add emphasis in body copy or as a section header, not in headlines.

Typography Style Example 1



DIN Next LT Pro Medium Condensed (all caps, tight leading) can be used for large, short headlines, with Lora Regular as a subhead. If section headers or short labels are necessary, all caps Lora Bold (75 tracking) may be used.
